Ralph will be on a 'home-coming tour' of the UK next month and, thanks to bassist Simon Woolf, we are on the circuit! Tenorist Vasilis Xenopoulos, a well-loved regular at Imber Court, will be joining Ralph for this memorable evening, and they will be ably supported by Fraser Urquhart on keyboard, drummer Mark Taylor - who happened to have spent 25 years playing the clubs in New York, and of course Simon.
