Karen toured with Humphrey Lyttelton's band and then, as an established soloist, worked with many of the top names in jazz. Runs her own groups, records albums as leader, enjoys working in big bands. Alex Clarke Quartet + Robert Fowler

Heavily influenced by the classic 1960's Clark Terry/Bob Brookmeyer Quintet, the group's mission statement is to play lively, fun and exciting jazz with an emphasis on melody and groove.
